**Declaration of Sampler
To
Discovery Seed Labs**

Instructions for filling out the samplers report

- A) The sample submitted to us must be an officially drawn sample as defined by the Canadian Seed Regulations. The person drawing the sample must be authorized to do so, such as an accredited grader, or by a person licensed to operate as an approved conditioner.
- B) For a US export the submitted sample size must not be less than one quart (US) or one liter in Canadian Size for agricultural seeds.
- C) For a Canadian grade the submitted sample size must not be less than stated in the Canadian Seed Regulations for the crop kind in question.
- D) For Canadian grading of seed, lines 1-5, 9-12, and 15-18 will have to be completed.
- E) For US exports of seed, lines 1-2, and 6-18 will have to be completed.
- F) Use one form for each lot number, if two or more shipments are to be made from the same lot number, the total size of the lot must be reported on the original form. The same PPQ 925 can then be used for the subsequent shipments.

The total weight must be reported in Lbs or Kgs.
